



GREAT MIGRATION SAFARI EAST AFRICA MAY 24 - June 05, 2013 *ESCORTED BY JOHN O'REGAN*

Itinerary in detail...

24 May 2013

Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport, you will be warmly welcomed by a member of the &Beyond team and assisted onto your road transfer to the Serena Mountain Village. Unwind for 1 night at **Mountain Village** in a standard room with ensuite bathroom. Your stay includes bed and breakfast.

Mountain Village Lodge is situated only 15kms from Arusha and is therefore an ideal venue for our starting point on this safari. The 46 "rondavel" style thatched huts are clustered together to give the impression of small individual Masai villages. Set in lush botanical gardens overlooking Lake Duluti, wonderful water features complement the indigenous flowers and bird life is abundant. All huts are en-suite with shower, mosquito nets and a private verandah. The main public area is in an old colonial house, which has been tastefully adapted and the central Fountain Restaurant serves organically grown fresh products. A roof terrace allows guests to enjoy panoramic views of Mt Kilimanjaro, Lake Duluti and Mt Meru. Recreational activities include guided bird watching walks around Lake Duluti, horse riding or traditional dancing on the lawns in the afternoon. A small curio shop is located near reception for guest's convenience.

25-26 May 2013

This morning after breakfast we depart for the short drive to the local domestic Arusha Airport for departure at 07h55 on our scheduled Tanganyika Flying Company flight to Klein's Airstrip arriving at 09h10.

Delight in 2 nights at **&Beyond Klein's Camp** in an intimate cottage with ensuite bathroom with shower only. Your stay includes three meals daily, soft drinks, house wines, local brand spirits and beers, teas and coffees, scheduled safari activities, refreshments on game drives and laundry.

Perched on the edge of the Kuka Hills, **&Beyond Klein's Camp** features intimate safari accommodation - just ten cottages of local stone and makuti, with rich wooden floors and classic interiors. A diversity of resident wildlife, including huge elephant herds, can be viewed from everywhere in camp - even the kitchen boasts unforgettable views.

The camp has a large, beautifully furnished bar and sitting area, a sparkling swimming pool, and a Safari Shop featuring locally-made Masai crafts. Fresh vegetables picked from the Camp's shamba (an organic African garden) create wholesome Pan African dishes. Dinners are served in the main dining area, which is graced by a large open fireplace, or enjoyed in a spectacular clearing deep in the heart of the African bush.

27-29 May 2013

This morning after our game drive and breakfast we will be transferred to the airstrip for departure at 09h35 on our scheduled Tanganyika Flying Company flight arriving at the Grumeti Airstrip at 10h30

On arrival at Manyara Airstrip we will be met for our private road transfer to Ngorongoro Crater Lodge. (Approx. 1 & 1/2 hour road transfer).

On arrival at Wilson Airport you will proceed to the Customs/Visa kiosk and secure our Kenyan Visas before connecting onto our scheduled Safari Link flight departing at 15h00 to Kichwa Tembo Airstrip arriving at 15h45.

Indulge in 3 nights at **&Beyond Bateleur Camp** in a spacious tent with ensuite bathroom and a private deck. Your stay includes accommodation, three meals daily, soft drinks, house wines, local brand spirits and beers, teas and coffees, refreshments on game drives, scheduled safari activities, return Kichwa Tembo airstrip transfers, emergency medical evacuation insurance and laundry.

This evening you will be met for your scheduled road transfer to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for departure on your scheduled flights.

05 June 2013 You will arrive in Europe this morning and continue back to the states arriving same day.

20 May 2013

This morning you will depart Ngala and fly to Kigali Rwanda via Johannesburg (subject to air schedules for 2012-your transit from South Africa to Rwanda may require an additional overnight in Johannesburg). Upon arrival in Kigali you will collect your luggage, clear customs and take the Top Tower Hotel Shuttle bus from the airport to the hotel. The balance of your day is at leisure. 21 May 2013
